

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Please respect our beautiful bushland and sculptures

All visitors to McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery grounds must observe the following Terms & Conditions of Entry:

- Entry is by donation.
- Obey speed limits.
- Park in the designated parking bays.
- Supervise children at all times.
- Do not touch, climb or in any other way, interfere with the sculptures.
- Smoking is only permitted in designated areas of the Park.
- Do not walk on tended gardens or remove flowers and/or plants.
- Do not feed the birds.
- No swimming.
- No alcohol. McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery is a licensed premises and alcohol is available for sale from the Café for consumption in designated areas within the Park.
- No barbeques.
- Do not play ball games or rideskateboards, scooters or bicycles in pedestrian areas.
- Take all rubbish with you when you leave.
- Keep dogs on leads at all times and remove any waste.
- Be careful of snakes, Bull ants, spiders and bees and respect all wildlife.
- Be aware that limbs and branches of trees may fall at any time.
- Walk with care, McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery's paths can be slippery.
- Tour Operators must book in advance and report to Reception.

All visitors to McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery buildings must observe the following:

- Entry is by donation.
- Supervise children at all times.
- Do not touch, or in any other way, interfere with artwork on display.
- No photography
- No smoking (smoking is permitted in designated areas of the Park).
- No eating or drinking in the galleries.
- No animals are permitted in the buildings, except for Guide Dogs and other registered assistance animals.
- Deposit at the Reception Desk, any backpacks, umbrellas, food or drink, large toys or game equipment (balls, cricket bats, etc.) or any other object as directed by McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery staff.
- Wear footwear at all times.
- Use a graphite pencil (not pens or paints) when taking notes or sketching in artwork display areas.

McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery reserves the right to:

- Exclude or remove any person from the grounds or any building managed or controlled by McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery.
- Inspect any bag, luggage or object upon entry to and before leaving McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery; and
- Use Security Closed Circuit Television cameras throughout McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery.

Whenever you are on McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery premises you must:

- Comply with McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery's rules and policies.
- Conduct yourself in a manner which, in the reasonable opinion of McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery, does not interfere with, disrupt or offend other persons on McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery premises.
- Comply with any reasonable request, including signage, by McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery in relation to your entry and continued presence on McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery premises.

Visitors enter the premises at their own risk. McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery will not accept responsibility for:

- Any loss of damage to any property (including any vehicle or contents) brought onto the premises; or
- Any injury to visitors or associates of visitors whilst on the property.

Upon entering the premises of McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery you agree to:

- Indemnify McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery in respect of all claims made in connection with your to McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery, except where such claim arises as a result of a negligent or wilful act, omission or otherwise, or an act or omission that is intended to cause damage or loss, by McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery; and
- To the full extent permitted by law, release and discharge McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery from all claims and demands on McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery and any loss or damage whatsoever and whenever caused, arising from your visit to McClelland Sculpture Park+Gallery.
